1 That the said Defendants were at the date
of the commencement of this action and still
are justly and truly indebted to the said
Plaintiffs in the sum of £161. 2. 10 for work
done and materials provided by me this
Deponent for the Defendants at their request
full particulars whereof have been duly delivered
to the said Defendants exceeding 3 folios in
length

2 And I the said Arthur Copping for myself
say:

By Indenture dated the 17th day of August
1891 between my Co-Deponent James Trollope
of the one part and the Plaintiffs of the other
part the said James Trollope in consideration

of £160. 0. 0 as beneficial Owner assigned
to the said Plaintiffs inter alia all monies
owing to him the said James Trollope by
the said Defendants therein stated and
described as Mess^{es} Hinds & Son of the Strand
Lower Walmer £153.15.5 and which Indenture
is now produced and shewn to me marked "A"

3 Notice of the aforesaid Indenture of Assignment
was duly sent to the said Defendants on the 17th
day of August 1891

4 The Writ of Summons in this Action is
specially endorsed

And we the said James Trollope and Arthur
Copping jointly say

5 We are advised and verily believe that the said
Defendants have no defence whatever to this Action
on the merits except as to the sum of £50 which
we are prepared to admit as a set off

I may at any time be liable to you and I authorise

£162. 2. 0 and all other moneys to bear interest
at £10 per cent per annum from the day on which
they became due The power of Sale conferred
