WE, the undersigned, being the statutory majority of Creditors assembled at the First General Meeting in the above matter, duly held at the New Corn Exchange Hotel Mark Lane in the City of London this 1st day of December, 1870, in accordance with the provisions of the said Act, do hereby resolve as follows:—
