TAKE NOTICE.

1. If any Creditor intends to OPPOSE the said Prisoner's Discharge NOTICE of such Intention must be given to the said Prisoner IN WRITING, which may be left at the Gaol, Two CLEAR Days before the Day of Hearing above-mentioned, EXCLUSIVE of Sunday, and EXCLUSIVE both of the Day of giving such Notice and of the said Day of Hearing.
2. The Petition and Schedule will be produced by the proper Officer for INSPECTION and EXAMINATION at the Office of the Court in London, between the Hours of Ten and Three, on this Notice being exhibited: and COPIES of the Petition and Schedule, or such Part thereof as shall be required, will be provided by the proper Officer according to the Act 1 and 2 Vict. c. 110, sec. 105.

3. The Duplicate of the \*Petition and Schedule, and all Books, Papers, and Writings, filed therewith, will be produced by the Clerk or Assistant Clerk of the said County Court, for INSPECTION and EXAMINATION at the Office of the said County Court at *Lancaster* aforesaid, and COPIES of the Petition and Schedule, or such Part thereof as shall be required will be provided according to sec. 100 of the Act.
