We enclose you copy letter ^{received} from
Messrs Ward & Co. of this morning.

We returned to them the draft order
approved yesterday but we confess we are
not at all satisfied with the correctness of
the order as we have no information
whatever about the Mortgages or the Leases,
the latter being as we should have supposed
the only contracts the disclaimer would
extend to. We should have thought it
would have been cheaper and better in
every respect for you to have made the

Trustee go on with his Motion and disclaim
but we can understand his preferring the
other course. In the one case his estate
(which perhaps means him to some
extent) would in all probability have
had to bear all the expenses, whilst in
the other he throws the expenses upon you.
